10-11 Time for shopping in the centre


11.30 Lunch at Kallion lukio cafeteria


13.30 -15.00 School ball dance at Kallion lukio, Lehtikuusentie 4

#### 1. Lehtikuusentie 4 Kallion lukio




2. Market square, meeting point for Suomenlinna ferry

#### How to pack and what to bring?
