

ROMANIA

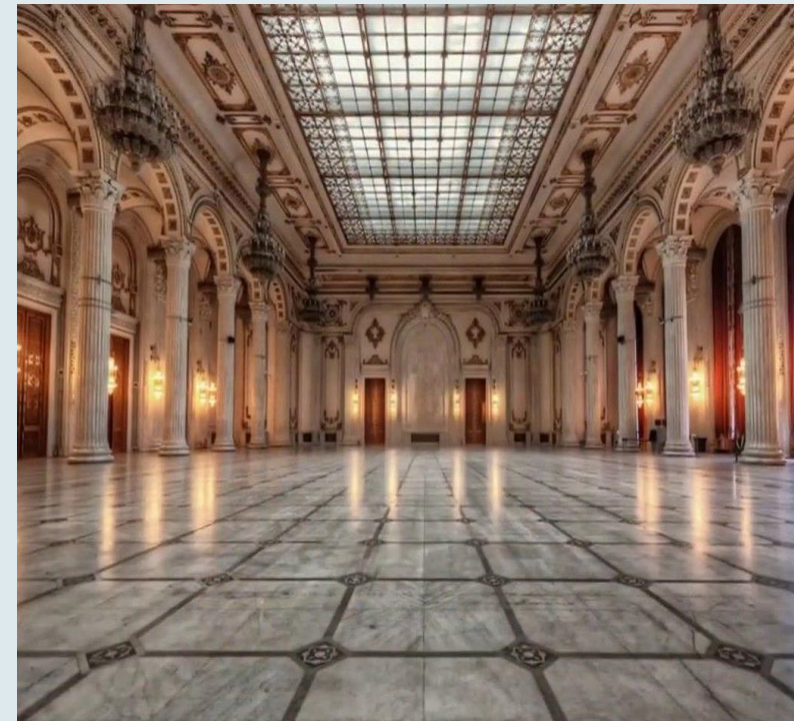


General information

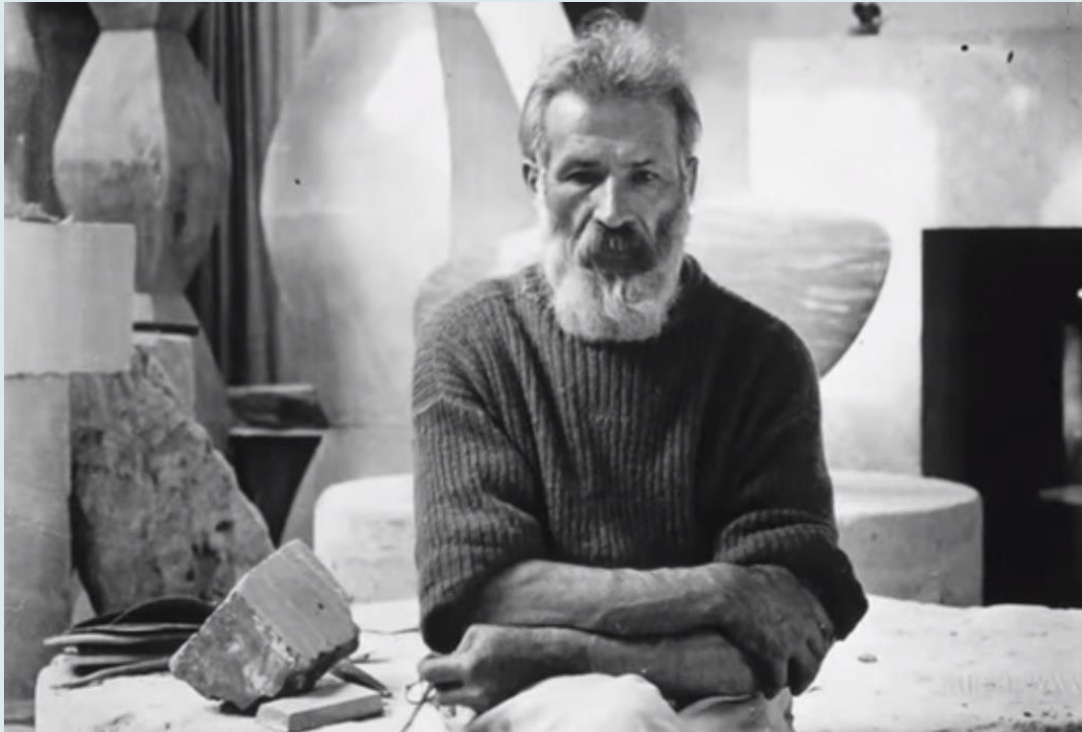
Mihai Eminescu
